

CHAPTER 8: TOWN HISTORIAN

§ 8.1 Legislative Intent

The Town of Camillus is proud of its heritage and pursuant to the authority of Article 57 of the Arts and Cultural Affairs Law of the State of New York hereby provides for the retrieval and preservation of historical information, materials and edifices. To assure the continuity of this undertaking, the Town Board has determined that it will be best accomplished by an organization rather than a particular person.

§ 8.2 Appointment of Town Historian

The Camillus Historical Society is hereby designated as the Town of Camillus Historian and said designation shall continue at the pleasure of the Town Board.

§ 8.3 Compensation

The Town Historian shall receive no compensation, however, the Town Board shall provide annually in the budget such an appropriation as in its judgment is necessary to support the Historians activities.

§ 8.4 Supersession

This local law is adopted pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Law and expressly supersedes the provisions of Section 57.13 of the Arts and Cultural Affairs Law to the extent that that Section grants to the Town Supervisor the authority to appoint a person as the Town Historian.

This was adopted as Local Law 19-1994, Sept.14, 1994.
