

CHAPTER 38: DUMPSTERS

§ 38.1 Purpose

The purpose of this Chapter is to promote the health, safety, morals and general welfare of the community by regulating the placement of dumpsters on other than single-family dwelling units. All dumpsters which have not been the subject of site plan review are subject to the following regulations.

§ 38.2 Permit Required

No dumpster shall be located or relocated unless a permit is first obtained from the Code Enforcement Officer upon payment of a fee of \$25.

§ 38.3 Application

Application for a permit to locate a dumpster shall be made upon a form to be provided which shall be accompanied by an accurate survey upon which there shall be shown the proposed location of the dumpster, together with any other details as may be required.

§ 38.4 General Regulations

- A. No dumpster shall be located in any required front yard as specified in Section 30.602B of this Code
- B. No dumpster shall be located in any required buffer strip as required by Section 30.1002 of this Code
- C. All dumpsters shall be screened with a stockade fence or other similar screen deemed appropriate by the Code Enforcement Officer, which screening shall be one foot in height above the top of the dumpsters it screens which shall not exceed eight feet in height.
