

CHAPTER 59: OUTDOOR STORAGE OF MOTOR VEHICLES

§ 59.1 Purpose

The outdoor storage of unlicensed motor vehicles is unsightly, could be dangerous and generally detracts from the aesthetic qualities of a residential neighborhood. Such storage may tend to discourage the improvement and good housekeeping of other properties and thereby depreciate a neighborhood. Therefore, in the interest of preservation of the general welfare and public health and safety of the residents of the Town of Camillus, the outdoor storage of unlicensed motor vehicles must be regulated.

§ 59.2 Regulation

It shall be unlawful for an owner or occupant of a residentially zoned parcel to store out-of-doors a motor vehicle which has not been licensed and inspected for public highway operation for more than six months.
