Supervisor Coogan called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of allegiance.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Several residents of Stonehedge Road voiced concerns about noise disturbances at and high levels of traffic coming and going from a residence on their road. Supervisor Coogan stated she was unaware of the severity of the situation. Councilor Griffo stated he would discuss the matter with the Police and Code Enforcement Departments; Supervisor Coogan concurred.

SUPERVISOR ANNOUNCEMENTS

Supervisor Coogan thanked employees who participated in the recent CPR training, noted that the annual fireworks were great; thanking the Camillus Police Department for their efforts, wished everyone a happy 4th of July holiday, and stated that the Town will be featured on channel 3's Our Town segment on July 26. She provided a reminder that trash pickup will be delayed one day during the week of July 4.

COUNCILOR COMMENTS

Councilor Griffo expressed concern with vehicle speeding issues within the Town and asked everyone to be alert.

ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES

Councilor Callahan moved to accept the minutes of the May 24, 2016 regular meeting and the June 6, 2016 and June 15, 2016 special meetings. Councilor James seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Resolution #136

Councilor Hammerle moved to approve the Certificate of Incorporation for the Camillus Middle Redevelopment Company. Councilor Callahan seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Resolution #137

Councilor Flood moved to set the date, time, and place as July 26, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Camillus Municipal Building to hold a public hearing to consider amending Camillus Municipal Code, Chapter 34-Fences, §34.7-Exceptions, to allow a fence in the front yard of the property located at 98 Huckleberry Lane, TM#: 019.-09-01.0. Councilor James seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Resolution #138

Councilor Callahan moved to set the date, time, and place as July 26, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Camillus Municipal Building to hold a public hearing to consider amending the Camillus Municipal Code, Chapter 60-Traffic & Vehicles, §60.43-Parking Prohibited in Designated Locations, to remove the no parking zone in the 100 block of Lynn Road. The motion was seconded by Councilor Flood and unanimously approved. Upon further review of the Municipal Code, it was determined that the signs were improperly placed, thus no public hearing is necessary and the Highway Department will be directed to remove them.

Resolution #139

Councilor Hammerle moved to set the date, time, and place as July 26, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Camillus Municipal Building to hold a public hearing to consider amending Chapter 30-Zoning, §1503-Amendments to the Zoning Map, the purpose of which is to change the zoning classification of the property located a 5742 Scenic Drive, TM #: 020.-03-17.3 from R1 to R3. Councilor Callahan seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Resolution #140

Councilor Hammerle moved to refer the zone change for 5742 Scenic Drive to SOCPA and the Camillus Planning Board. Councilor LaFlair seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Resolution #141

Councilor Griffo moved that the Town of Camillus establish a seven hour workday as the standard workday for Richard Griffo for purposes of New York State Retirement system reporting. Councilor James seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Resolution #142

Councilor Callahan moved to amend resolution #134 of June 6, 2016, to correct the house number of the item on Bitters Road from 2167 to 2176. Councilor James seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Resolution #144

Councilor Hammerle moved to authorize the Town Supervisor to sign the lease between the Town of Camillus and John Lytle for use of the property located at 6066 Gillie Brook Road/Veteran's Memorial Park at Gillie Lake for the period from August 1, 2016 through August 1, 2017. Councilor Callahan seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Resolution #145

Councilor Flood moved to set the date, time, and place as July 26, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Camillus Municipal Building to hold a public hearing to consider amending the Camillus Municipal Code, Chapter 34-Fences, §34.7-Exceptions, the purpose of which is to allow a fence in the front yard of the property located at 139 Gillespie Avenue, TM #: 042.-05-01.0. Councilor Callahan seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Resolution #146

Councilor Callahan moved to renew the Town's Worker's Compensation policy with PERMA at an annual cost of \$326,074.00. Councilor James seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Resolution #147

Councilor Callahan seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Resolution #148

Councilor Callahan moved to approve the settlement amount of \$3000.00 to Gary J. Murphy. Councilor Flood seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Resolution #149

Supervisor Coogan moved to accept the bid of \$173,229.00 from Haylor, Freyer, & Coon for liability, property, & casualty insurance provided by Houston Casualty Insurance, Allianz, and National Grange Mutual companies, effective August 1, 2016. Councilor Callahan seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Joe Flynn of Friends of Camillus Park stated that Pickleball has begun in Camillus Park and that they will have a tailgate party on the first Friday of each month.
