

SEPTEMBER 27, 2016 - REGULAR MEETING OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF CAMILLUS, COUNTY OF ONONDAGA, STATE OF NEW YORK, HELD AT THE CAMILLUS MUNICIPAL BUILDING.

Supervisor Coogan called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

**PUBLIC HEARING #1**

Consider repealing and replacing Chapter 31-Flood Damage Prevention with the new model code recommended by FEMA and NYS DEC.

Mr. Oudemool explained that the Town is proposing to adopt the model code and, in addition to that, incorporate four of the alternatives which although make for a more stringent law, will theoretically reduce the premiums that residents need to pay. He noted he has submitted the proposed law to the New York State DEC for approval and, although he has not heard back, he anticipates it should be approved since the Town is following their model.

**Resolution #188**

Councilor Callahan moved to close the public hearing. Councilor James seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

**Resolution #189**

Councilor Callahan moved to approve amending Camillus Municipal Code by repealing and replacing Chapter 31-Flood Damage Prevention with the proposed model law. Councilor Griffo seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

A resident who expressed concerns about activities at the Camillus Park Splashpad at the last meeting inquired whether the Board has looked into their concerns. Supervisor Coogan stated the Board is looking at it and will be addressing it.

**SUPERVISOR ANNOUNCEMENTS**

Supervisor Coogan stated the work on the 2017 Town budget is continuing.

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### **COUNCILOR COMMENTS**

Councilor Flood thanked Chief Winn for assisting with traffic issues in Stanley Manor (Sunnybrook Drive) and thanked the Highway Department for doing the related road striping work.

Councilor James announced that the Fairmount Fire Department will be hosting their Open House on Sunday, October 2 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The event will feature aerial truck rides, demonstrations on vehicle fire and rescues, bounce house, free blood pressure checks, and free pizza.

Councilor Callahan stated he'd be setting a Finance Committee meeting soon to review the Landfill numbers and receivable list. He noted there were many questions from the new residents of Camillus Pointe Senior Apartments about voting locations. They will be voting at St. Joseph's Church and he did drop of voter registration forms for anyone there who needed one.

Councilor LaFlair moved to accept the minutes of the September 13, 2016 meeting. Councilor Flood seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

#### **Resolution #190**

Councilor Hammerle moved to approve the proposed contract with the Cayuga County Soil and Water Conservation District to provide a boom mower and/or bat-wing mower to perform mowing services in the Erie Canal Park. Councilor Flood seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

#### **Resolution #191**

Councilor Flood moved to promote Police Officer Stephen A. Pigula to the position of Sergeant, with an annual base salary of \$71,609.00 and a 26 week probation period, effective September 27, 2016. The motion was unanimously seconded and approved.

#### **Resolution #192**

Councilor Callahan moved to accept the bid of \$54,900.00, with an increase in the local share from \$15,000.00 to \$20,900.00, from Salt Springs Paving for the Senior Center parking lot paving project. Councilor Hammerle seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

#### **Resolution #192**

Councilor LaFlair moved to set the date, time, and place as October 11, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Camillus Municipal Building to hold a public hearing to consider amending Chapter 44-

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Town Highways and Public Places, §44.11-Driveway Design Standards, (A), (8), to add an additional exception to allow a 33' wide driveway on the property located at 109 Weeping Willow Way, TM#: 018.-09-35.0. Councilor Callahan seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
